

HOUSE TOUR

This two-hour tour features the interior spaces and exterior courtyards and gardens of Frank Lloyd Wright's private residence, Taliesin. Begun in 1911, Taliesin became Wright's work-in-progress during the next 48 years, as he reworked and added to it, bringing it ever closer to his architectural ideal. By passing through these magnificent spaces, filled with his furnishings and art collections, visitors will experience the intimacy and genius of one of America's greatest architects.

HILLSIDE STUDIO AND THEATER TOUR

This one-hour tour features one of the earliest structures on the estate. A revolutionary design for Wright, Hillside was built on three levels to follow the natural slope of the hill it rests on. Built in 1902 as a boarding school for his two aunts, it was converted into the Frank Lloyd Wright School of Architecture in the 1930s, and is still in operation today. Visitors will see living, active spaces, including the 5,000-square-foot drafting studio, the spacious assembly hall, and the jewel-like theater, all while learning about Wright's life and prolific career in this wonderful introductory tour.

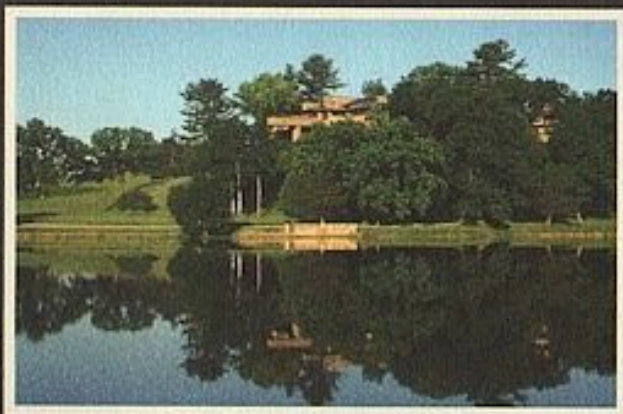
HIGHLIGHTS TOUR

This two-hour tour is a faster-paced combination of the House and Hillside tours, highlighting the interior spaces of both of these National Historic Landmarks. In addition, visitors will enjoy exterior views of some of Wright's other buildings as they are driven across the beautiful 600-acre estate. This tour is ideal for visitors with limited time who want to experience both structures, or for visitors interested in comparing the interior architecture of different periods of Wright's career.

ESTATE TOUR

This four-hour tour, our most comprehensive, is consistently cited by architecture enthusiasts as the highlight of their travels. Combining interior tours of both Taliesin and Hillside, a stop at Unity Chapel, a walk through the rolling hills of the estate, and a refreshment break on Mr. Wright's private terrace, this experience offers a unified view of seven decades of Wright's work in the valley which continually gave him inspiration.

PREPARING FOR YOUR TOUR

Photography, for personal use, is only permitted outdoors. No interior photography allowed. All tours cover uneven terrain and go out rain or shine. Walking shoes and comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing are recommended. No smoking is allowed on the Taliesin estate. No restrooms are available during the course of the tours, with the exception of the Estate Tour; they are available in the FLLW Visitor Center. No food or beverage, except for water, is allowed on the tours. Bottled water is available for purchase in the FLLW Visitor Center.

All tours begin at the Frank Lloyd Wright Visitor Center, located two miles south of Spring Green, WI, at the intersection of Hwy. 23 and Cty. Rd. C. Taliesin is one hour west of Madison, WI, 2.5 hours west of Milwaukee, WI, 3.5 hours from Chicago, IL, and 5 hours from Minneapolis, MN. 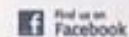
