Please read the application instructions carefully. A separate application is needed for each child applying and there is a limit of one scholarship per student.

Application deadline is April 15.

All submissions will be reviewed and applicants notified by May 1.

Scholarship Guidelines:

- Applicants are evaluated without regard to race, religion, national origin, sex or physical ability
- Award is based on financial need and student statement
- Financial need will be determined by the family's income and number of dependents
- Funding is limited and scholarships are not guaranteed to all applicants
- Staff of Taliesin Preservation and their children are not eligible for scholarship assistance
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed
- Application materials will not be returned
