



Scholarship Procedures/Guidelines

Summary: Taliesin Preservation has funds available to assist adults and youth with scholarships towards programming (excluding tours and Field School). The purpose of this scholarship fund is to increase accessibility to participants whose financial situation might prohibit them from participating in public programming offered by Taliesin Preservation.

Guidelines: Scholarship applications will be available for any program, as noted above, offered by Taliesin Preservation via a link on the website (www.taliesinpreservation.org) or by request. Applications must be received within 30 days before the program's start date. Applications must be completed and will be reviewed by Taliesin Preservation weekly.

Taliesin Preservation awards grants on an objective and non-discriminatory basis, and the sole purpose is to provide greater access to mission-related programming. Scholarships are awarded until existing funds have been distributed.

Scholarships offered through Taliesin Preservation award applicants up to 50% off workshop fees and up to 75% off summer camp fees.

Review Process:

- Applicants are evaluated without regard to race, religion, natural origin, gender, or physical ability.
- Award is based on financial need and desire to participate.
- Financial needs will be determined by the family's reported adjusted gross income (AGI) and number of dependents.
- Funding is limited and scholarships are not guaranteed to all applicants.
- Staff of Taliesin Preservation and their children are not eligible for scholarship assistance.
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
- Application materials will not be returned.

Notification: Applicants will be notified by email of approval/denial within 5 days of review.
